Inspired by the geometric shape of an arch, Archie is a chair featuring slender, elegant legs that extend upwards to embrace the curved backrest in a single, seamless line. The visible joints between the structure's planes underscore a meticulous process of refinement, balancing visual lightness, structural integrity, and comfort. "Archie makes a sculptural statement, where the back and arm merge into a single, fluid form," say George Yabu and Glenn Pushelberg. With Archie, the studio pushes MDF Italia's legacy of technical innovation by creating a sleek, minimalist structure that blends the company's know-how with the studio's inventive spirit. Archie is removable and designed to be fully disassembled.

Seat and backrest

- The seat is made of plywood sourced from sustainably managed forests, fitted with elastic webbing and upholstered with PET fibre and a differentiated-density polyurethane insert.
- The backrest is made of co-moulded thermoplastic material and polyurethane.

Cover

Fabric or leather, removable cover.

Powder-coated steel tubular legs, 16 mm in diameter, conical at the top.
